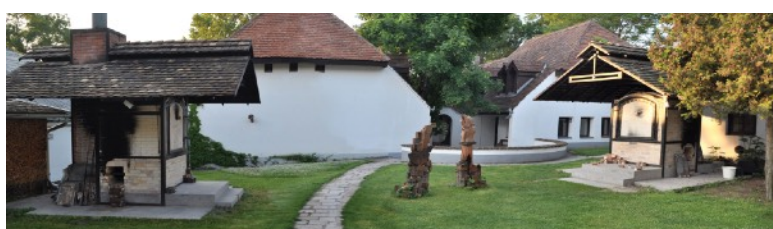


International Ceramics Studio Kecskemét, Hungary

Facilities

The studio has an impressive range of facilities, including specialist equipment not usually available to students in normal educational establishments, providing them with increased opportunities and experiences. Students have exceptional 24 hour access to workshops and equipment, breaking down the barriers between education, life and art.



Alongside our specialist resident artist staff members, teachers and professors, leading Hungarian artists and world-famous artists invited by the Studio also teach while making their own work. Students are able to learn in a supportive and mutually creative way, experiencing philosophy, processes of thought and technical expertise of the masters.



HOW MUCH WILL IT COST ?

On site accommodation, large studio spaces, excellent facilities, kilns, equipment, specialist technicians , library, lounges, modern kitchens, bed linen and towels - all this is included in the accommodation costs.

MAKING A RESERVATION

A 50% deposit is required to secure your requested time periods. The remaining balance should be paid by bank transfer in advance of the group arrival or in cash on arrival at the studio.

During your stay at the ICS you will live in the studio buildings, giving you full access to your workshop and studio space at all times, catering for every work regime you set for yourself and your students.

Accommodation is in several restored houses, with most bedrooms on the upper floor. Houses are central heated and have lounges, communal meeting rooms, kitchens and dining areas where visiting artists can relax and socialise in a beautiful environment.

The beautiful market town of Kecskemét is the county town of Bacs Kiskun and is situated about 80 kilometres south of the Hungarian capital, Budapest, in the centre of the Great Plain. It is a city of about 120,000 people and has many restaurants, shops, cafes, supermarkets, bars, cinemas and theatres, museums and cultural institutes.

Kecskemét is well served by public transport - both trains and buses. Journey time from Budapest is about one and a half hours by both train and bus. The Bus and Train station in Kecskemét are right beside each other and about a 15 minute walk to the studio. The studio is in the city centre, about 5 minutes from the main square of the town.

There are many festivals and fairs throughout the year and each summer there are concerts, dances and entertainment in the town square making Kecskemét a lively and culturally diverse city.
